



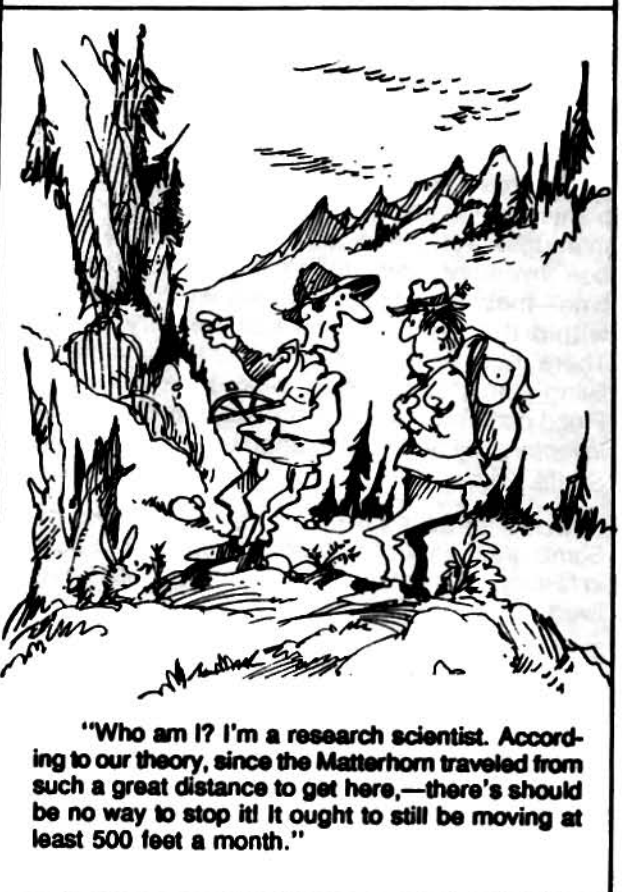
"Why are sea shells way up here?"
